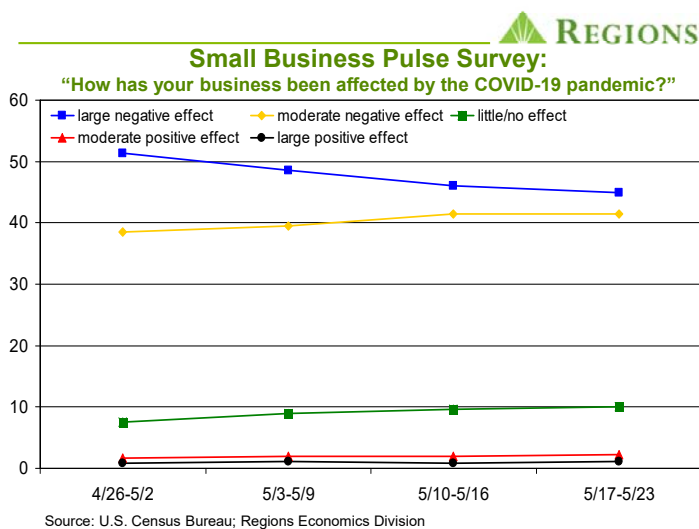

Small Business Pulse Survey: Regions Footprint

The U.S. Census Bureau has released the latest weekly installment of its *Small Business Pulse Survey*, the counterpart to the recently introduced *Household Pulse Survey*. The *Small Business Pulse Survey* is designed to measure changes in conditions amongst small businesses during the COVID-19 pandemic. Survey results are available on the national and state levels, as well as for the nation's 50 largest (based on population) metro areas, a group which includes 19 metro areas within the Regions footprint. Our weekly summaries include the U.S. averages and individual snapshots of each of the 15 in-footprint states and the 19 in-footprint metro areas for which data are available. The latest survey period covered May 17 through May 23.



The chart to the side shows the history of responses (U.S. averages) to the broad question of how the respondent's business has been affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. As seen in the chart, the overwhelming majority of small business owners report either a moderate or large negative impact, which is not at all surprising. Over the four weeks of the survey period (Census intends to conduct the surveys for three months, which may or may not be extended), the share of small business owners reporting a large negative effect has fallen modestly. What will be interesting to watch in the weeks ahead will be how the responses to this broad question change as states take steps to reopen economic activity.

The details beneath this broad question are more telling. For instance, business owners are asked how sales/revenue, the number of paid employees, and the total number of employee hours worked have changed, and other questions pertaining to business/financial conditions. Even over the thus far limited life of the *Small Business Pulse Survey*, the shares of small business owners reporting increasing sales/revenue and increases in the

number of paid employees and hours worked have risen. To be sure, these shares are still low, but are at least moving in the right direction, and this is true across most of the individual geographies within the Regions footprint. It will be interesting to see if the rate of increase in these metrics picks up in the weeks ahead as states take steps to relax restrictions on activity, and whether the differences in the rates at which individual states take these steps are reflected in the responses of small business owners across the different states.

In the pages that follow, we present summaries of what we consider the most relevant questions from the *Small Business Pulse Survey* for the individual states and largest metro areas within the Regions footprint, and will continue to provide these weekly summaries for the duration of the survey, as we also do with the *Household Pulse Survey*.
