Notes On Initial and Continuing Claims: Regions Footprint

Initial Claims:

During the week ending February 13, a total of 240,383 people within the Regions footprint applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits, down from 242,067 people in the week ending February 6;

Illinois, Kentucky, and Missouri saw increases in initial claims in the week ending February 13;

Nationally, 710,313 people filed claims during the week ending February 20, down from 842,047 in the week ending February 13.

Continuing Claims:

As of the week ending February 6, a total of 1,516,228 people within the Regions footprint were receiving regular Unemployment Insurance benefits, down from 1,507,250 in the week ending January 30;


Florida, Kentucky, Mississippi, and Texas saw increases in continuing claims in the week ending February 6;

It should be noted that declines in continuing claims can reflect either people having exhausted their regular state-level benefits or having returned to work;

More than 2.284 million people across the Regions footprint are drawing Unemployment Insurance benefits through the various pandemic relief programs; these numbers are not included in the regular claims data cited above.



weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Florida




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Iowa
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted








Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Indiana




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Kentucky
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted






Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Louisiana




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Missouri
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted








Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Mississippi




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: North Carolina
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: South Carolina

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Tennessee
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




