Notes On Initial and Continuing Claims: Regions Footprint

Initial Claims:

During the week ending March 13, a total of 279,206 people within the Regions footprint applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits, up from 235,811 people in the week ending March 6;

Alabama, Florida, Iowa, Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Louisiana, North Carolina, Tennessee, and Texas saw increases in initial claims in the week ending March 13;

Nationally, 656,789 people filed claims during the week ending March 20, down from 757,201 in the week ending March 13.

Continuing Claims:

As of the week ending March 6, a total of 1,330,971 people within the Regions footprint were receiving regular Unemployment Insurance benefits, down from 1,332,805 in the week ending February 27;

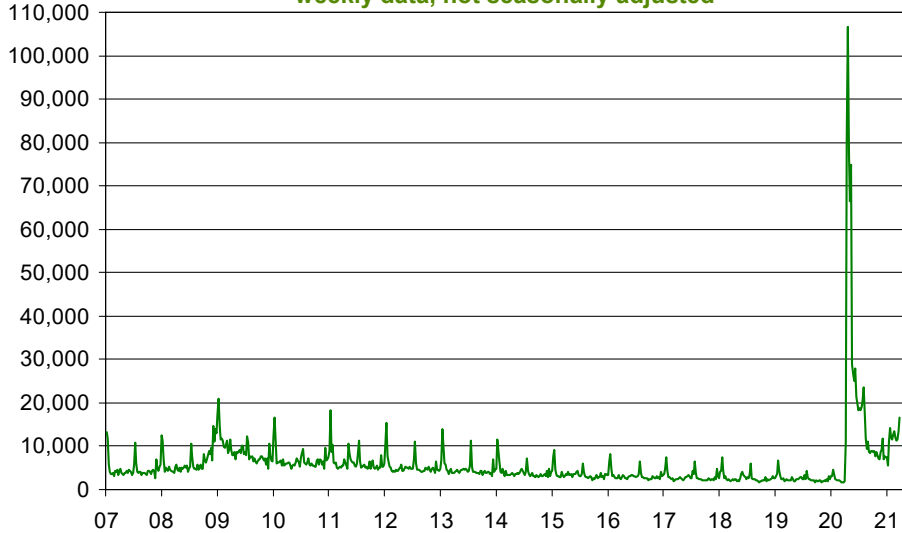
Texas was the only state to see an increase in continuing claims in the week ending March 6;

It should be noted that declines in continuing claims can reflect either people having exhausted their regular state-level benefits or having returned to work;

More than 2.677 million people across the Regions footprint are drawing Unemployment Insurance benefits through the various pandemic relief programs; these numbers are not included in the regular claims data cited above.

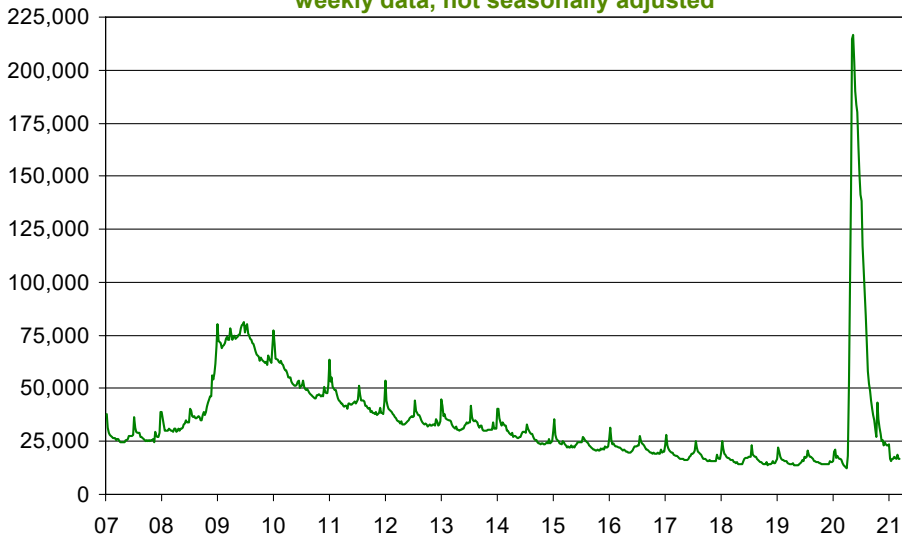

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



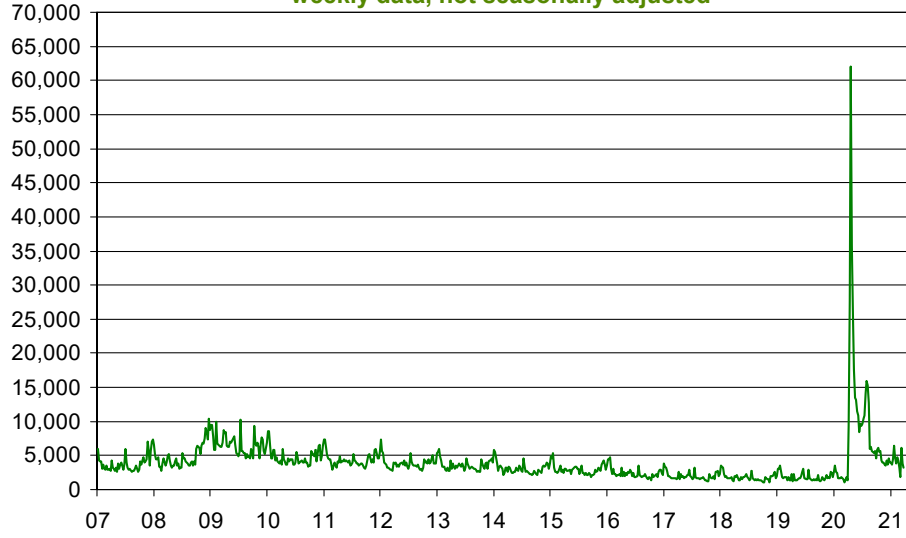

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



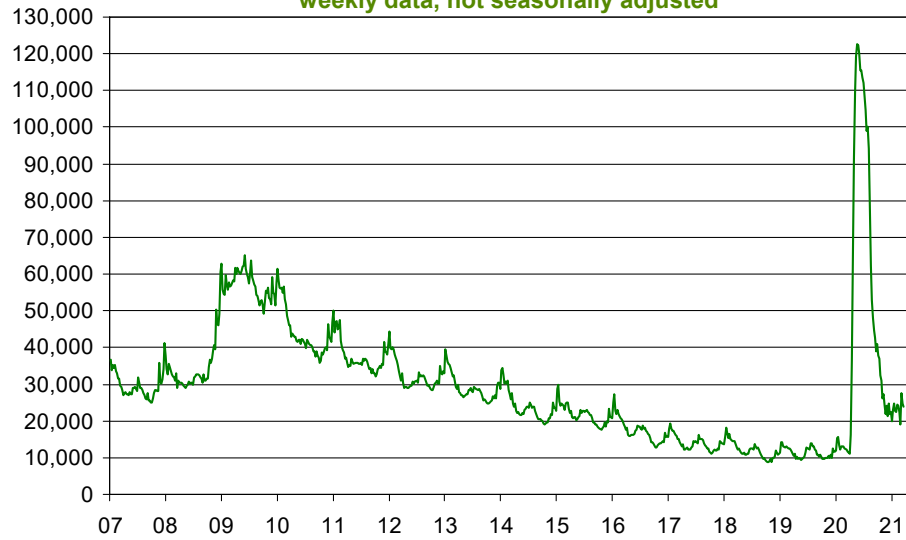

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



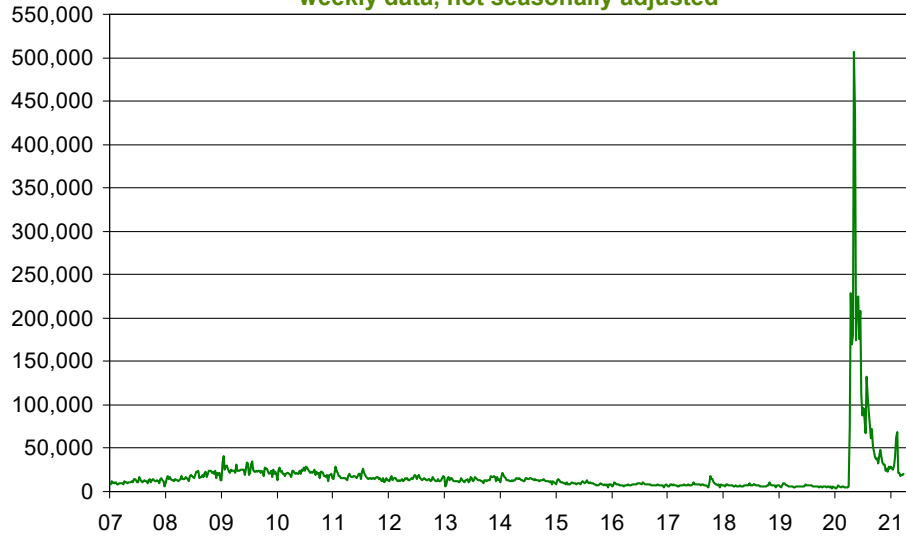

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



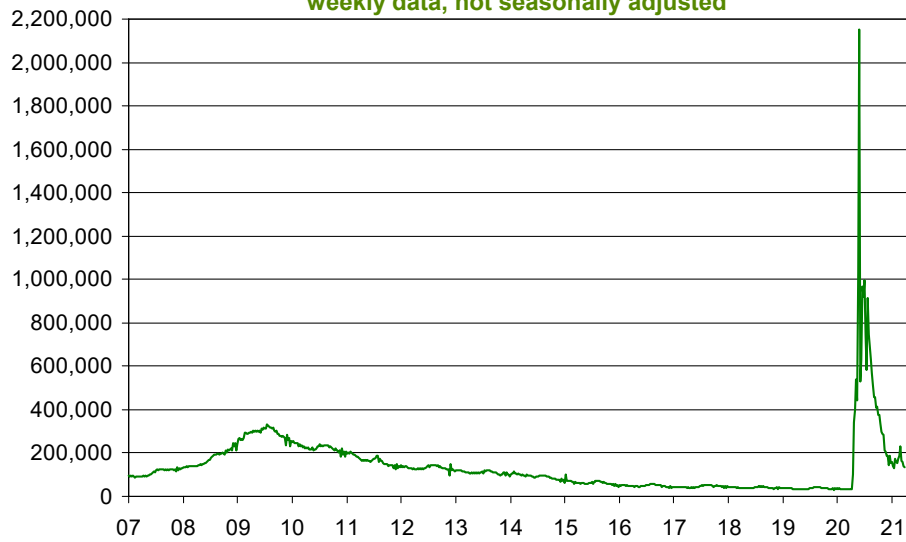

weekly data, not seasonally adjusted

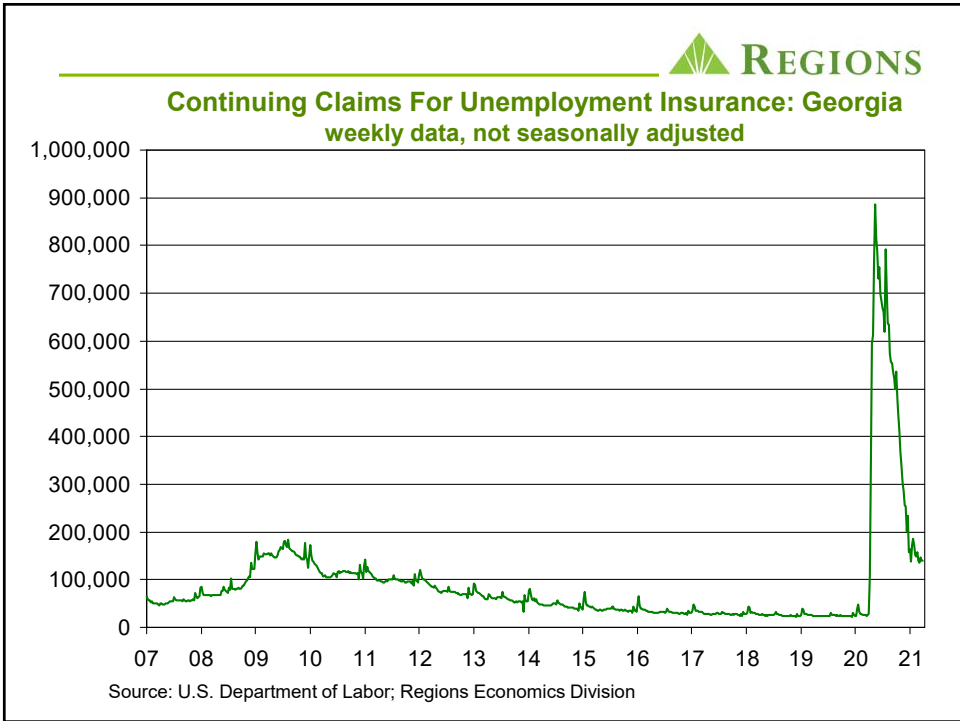
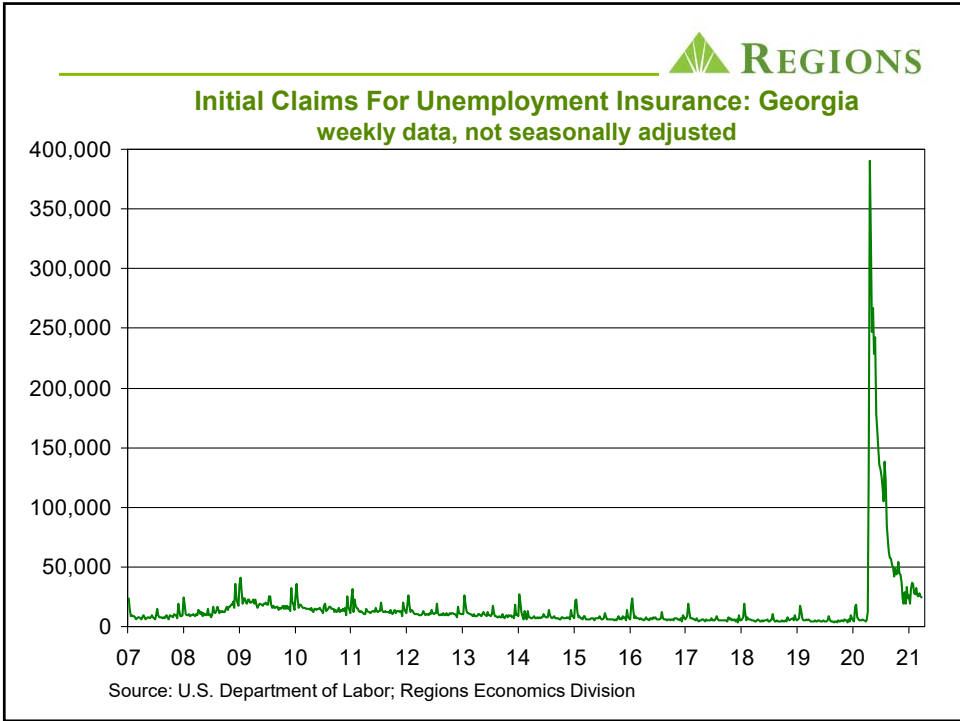

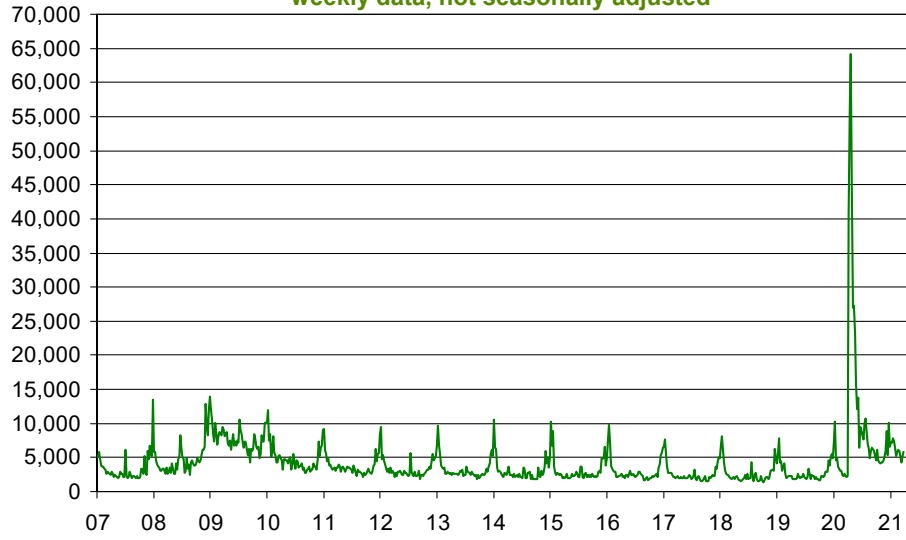
Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Florida

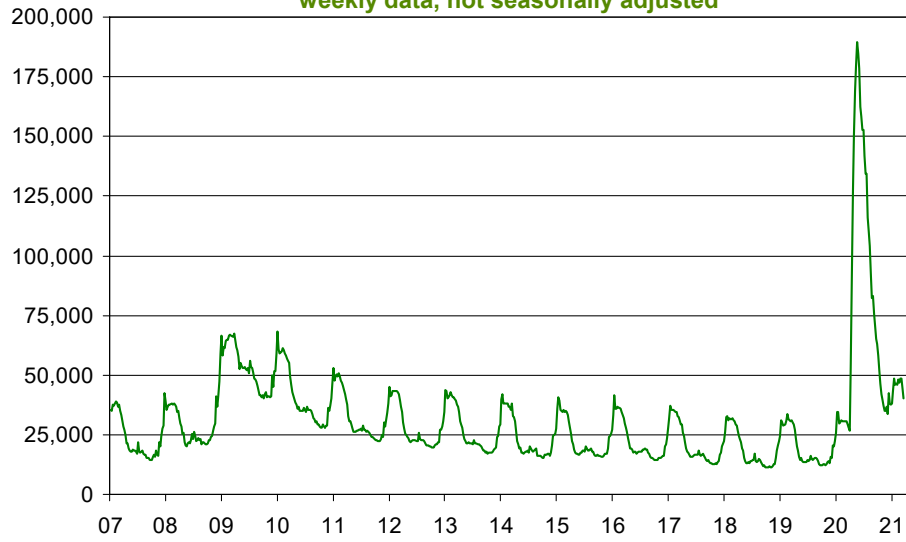


Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Iowa
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



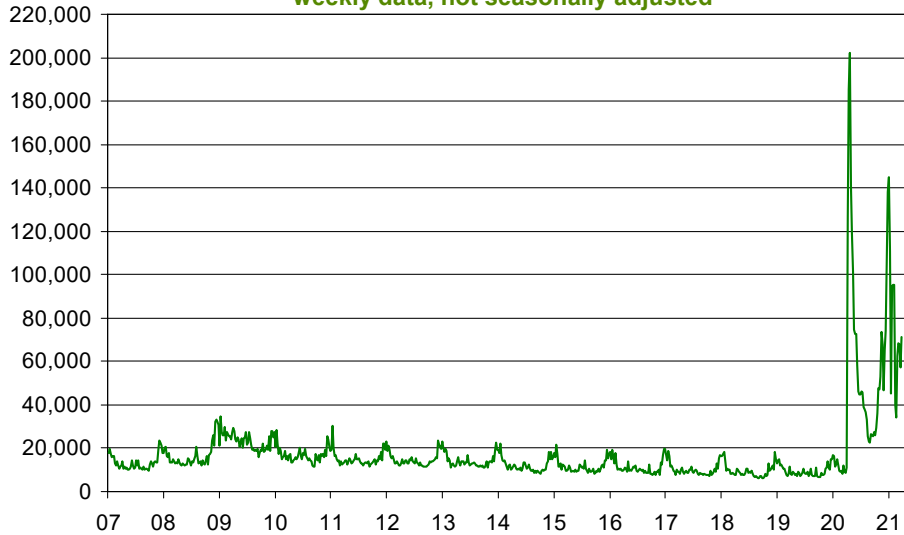

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



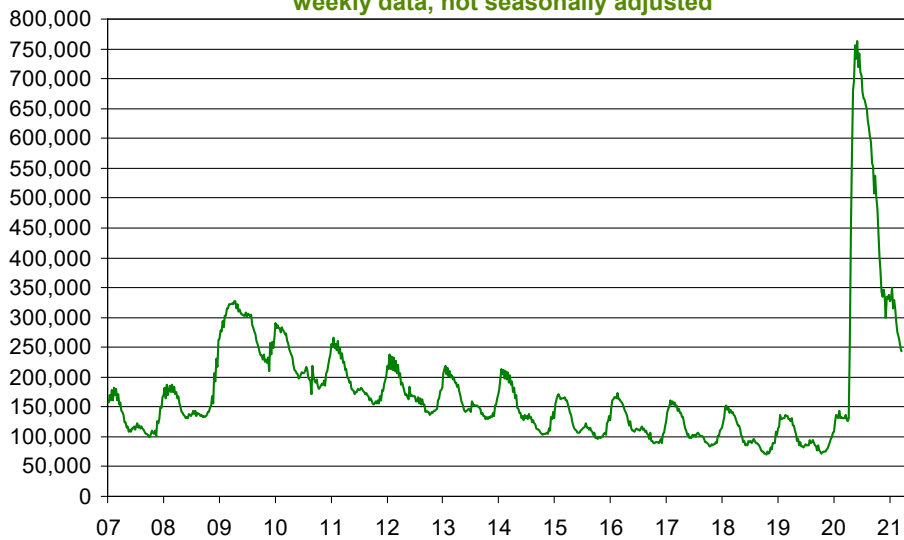

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



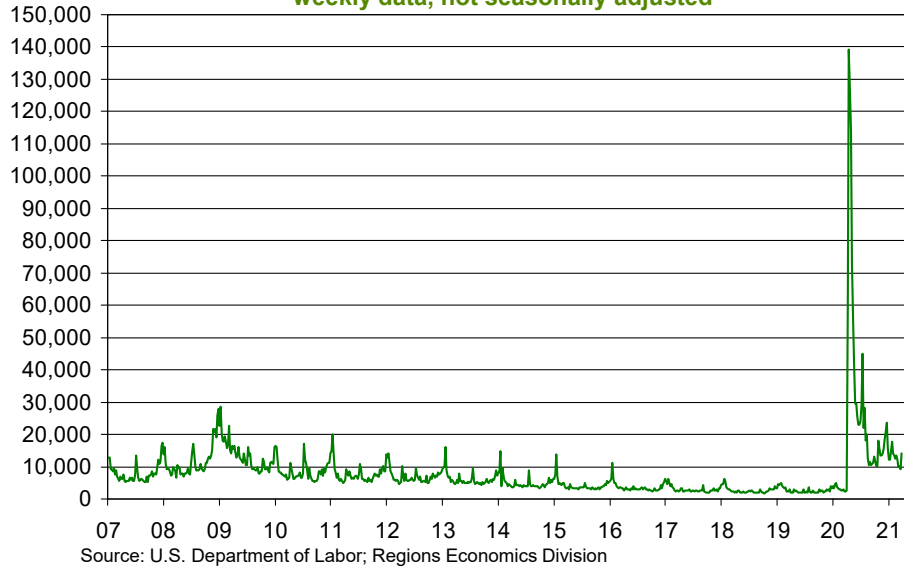

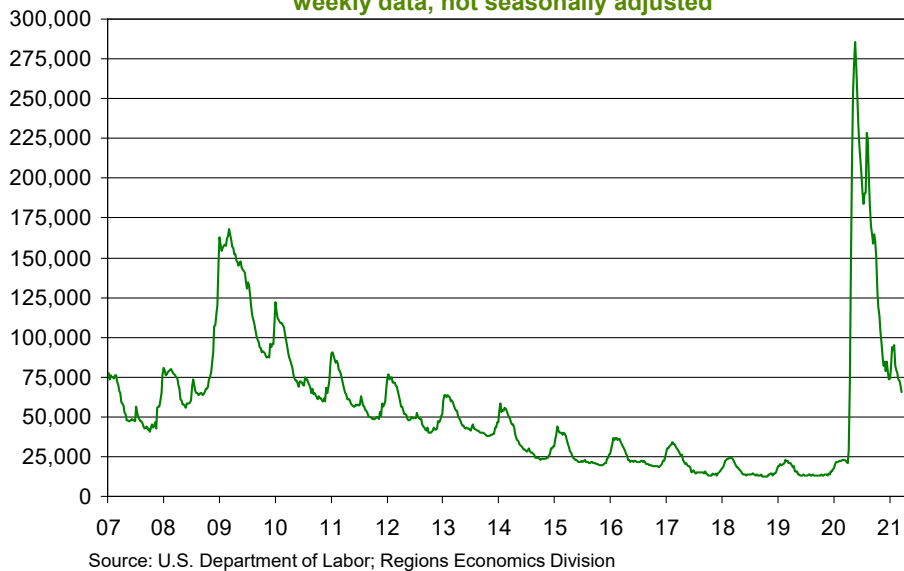

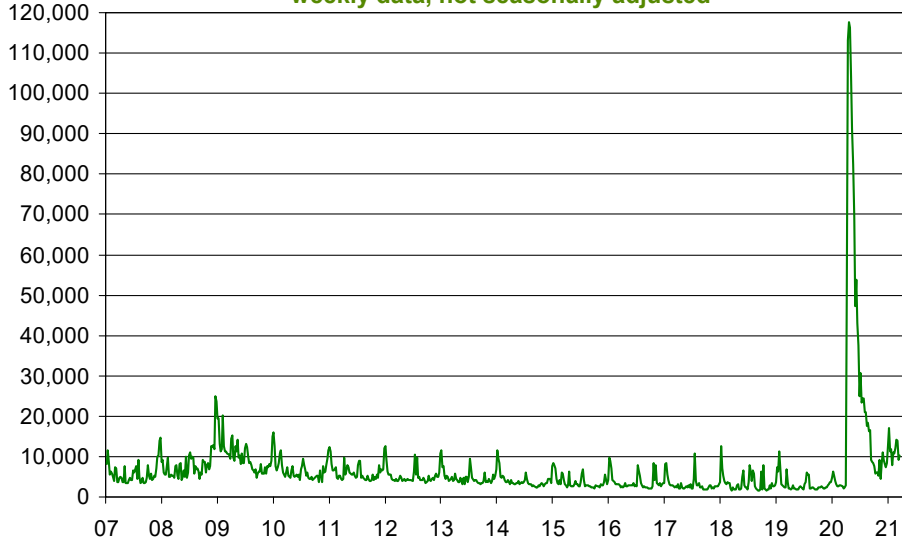
Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Indiana

weekly data, not seasonally adjusted

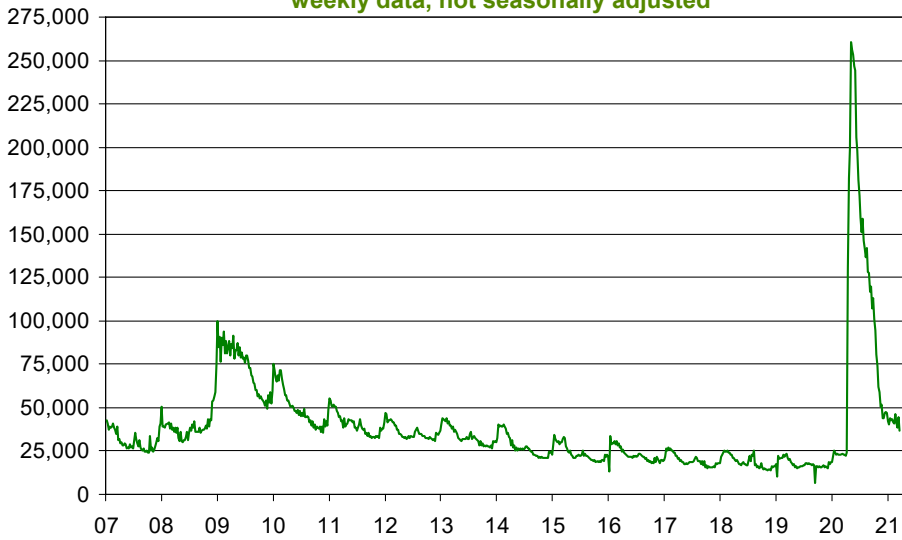


Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Kentucky
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



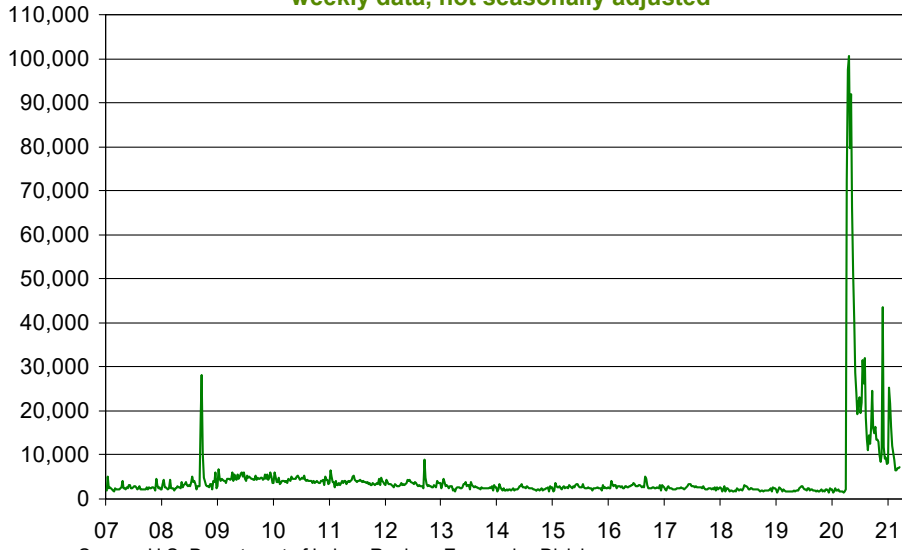

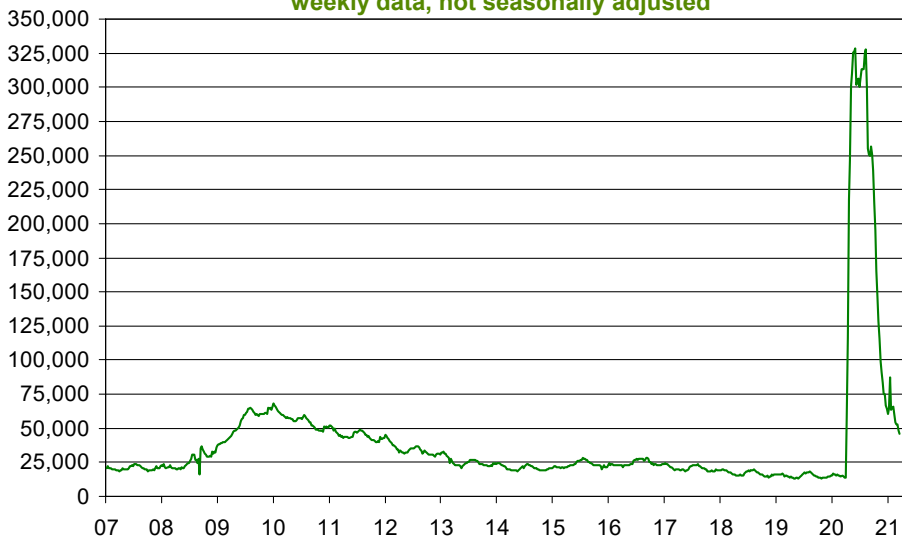

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



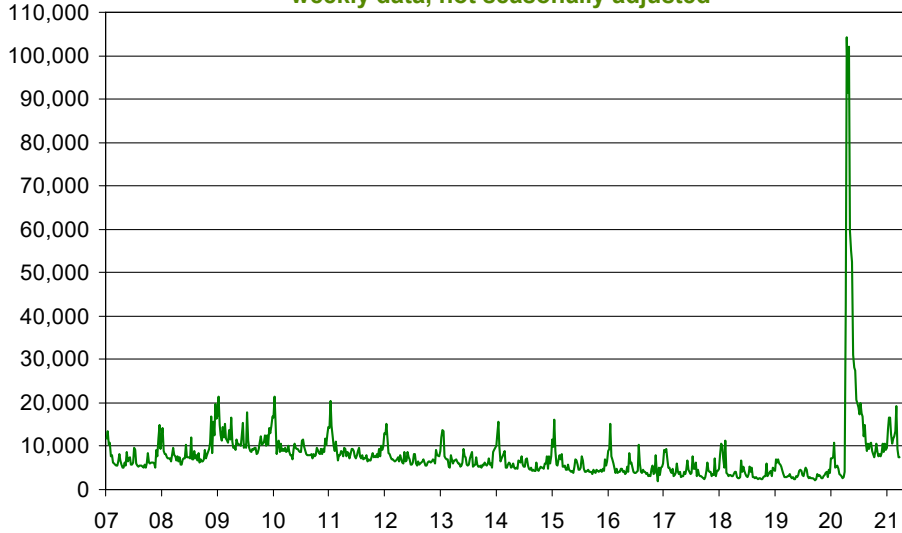

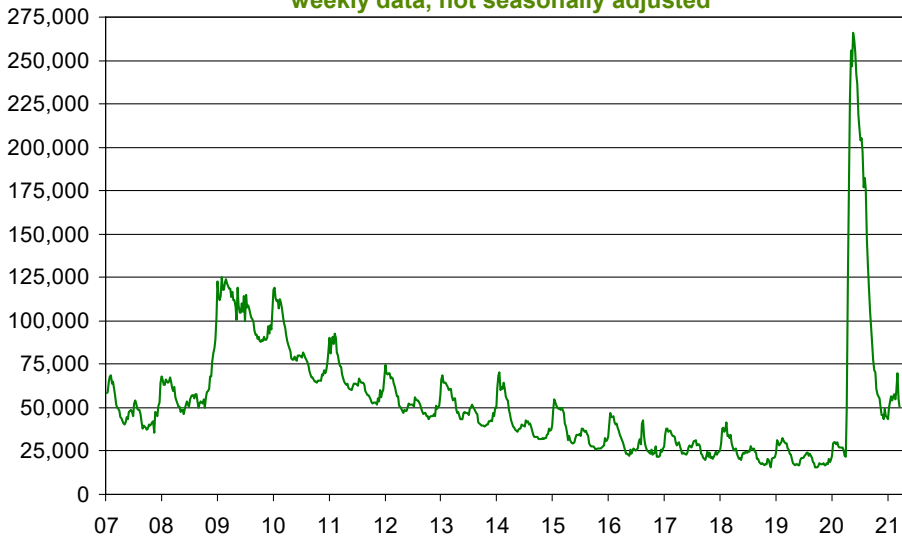

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



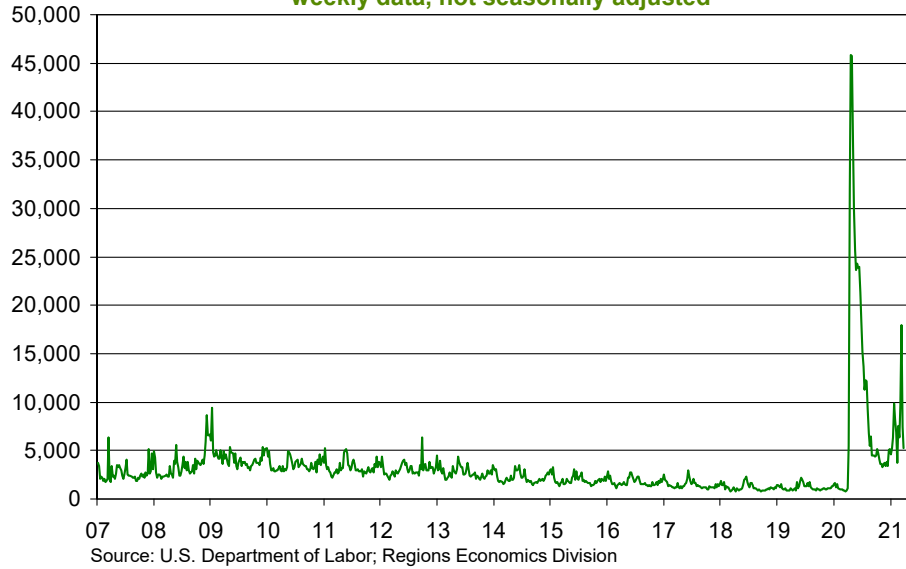

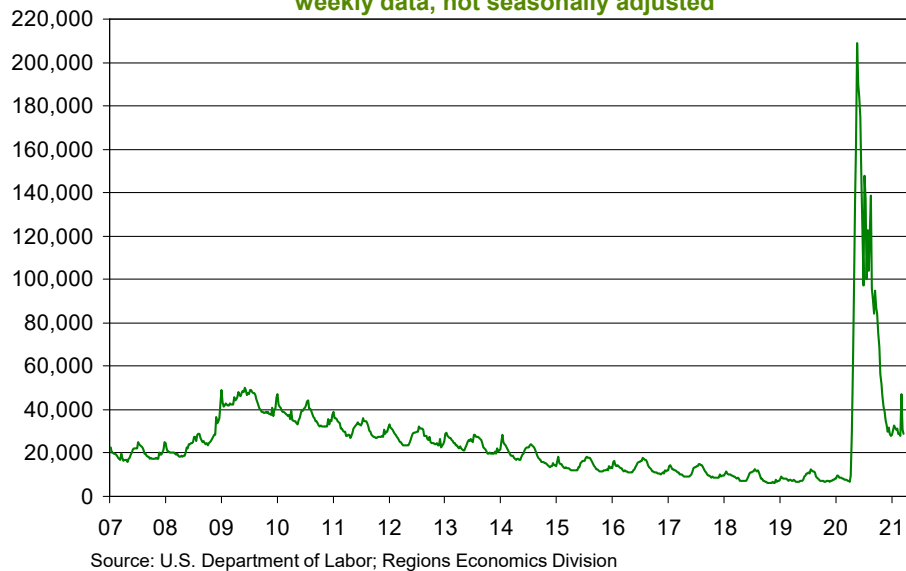

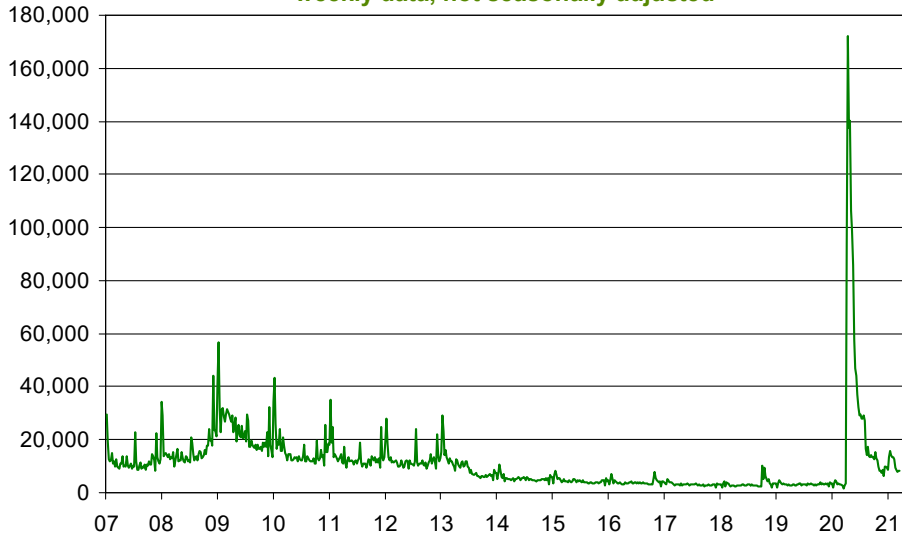
Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Mississippi

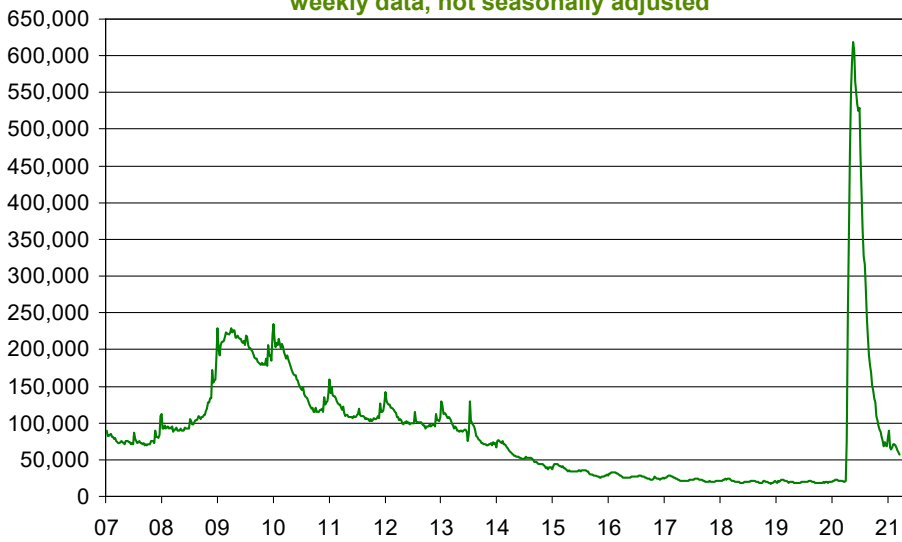


Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: North Carolina
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



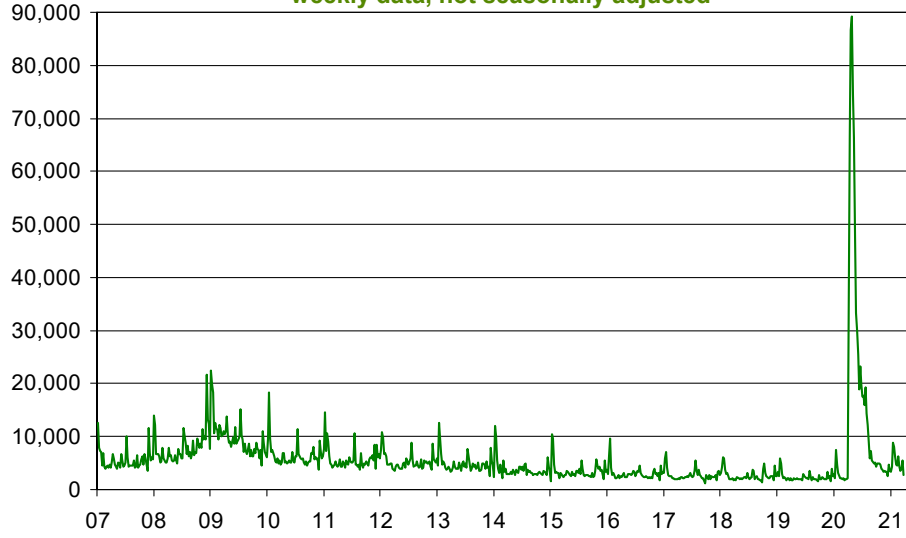

weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



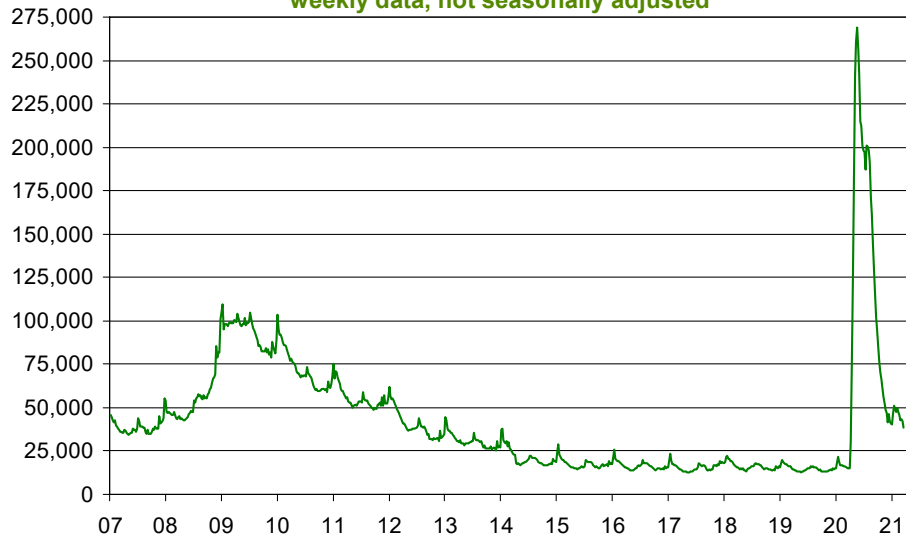

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



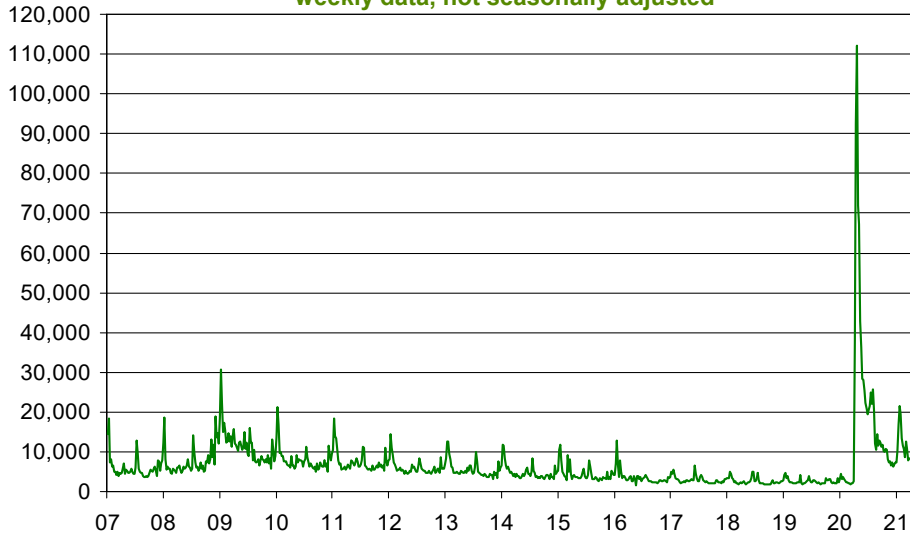

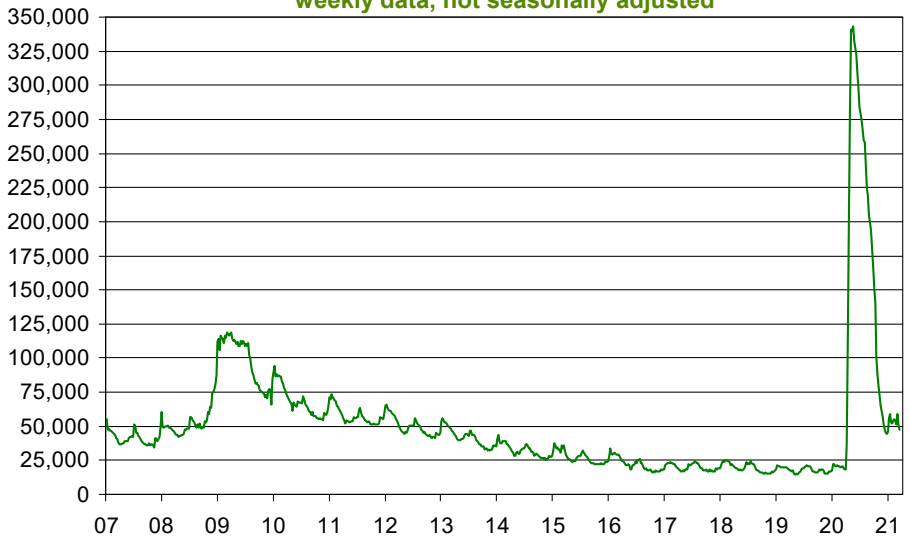

weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



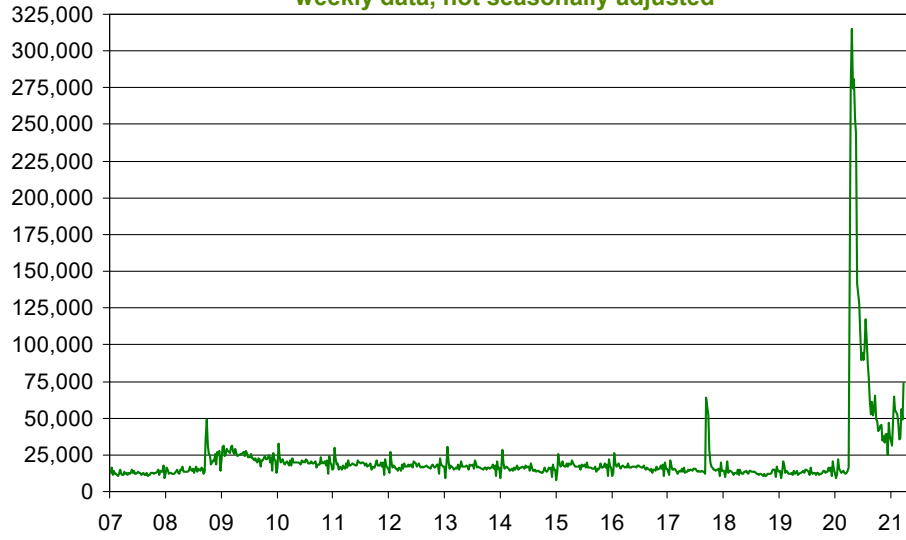

weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



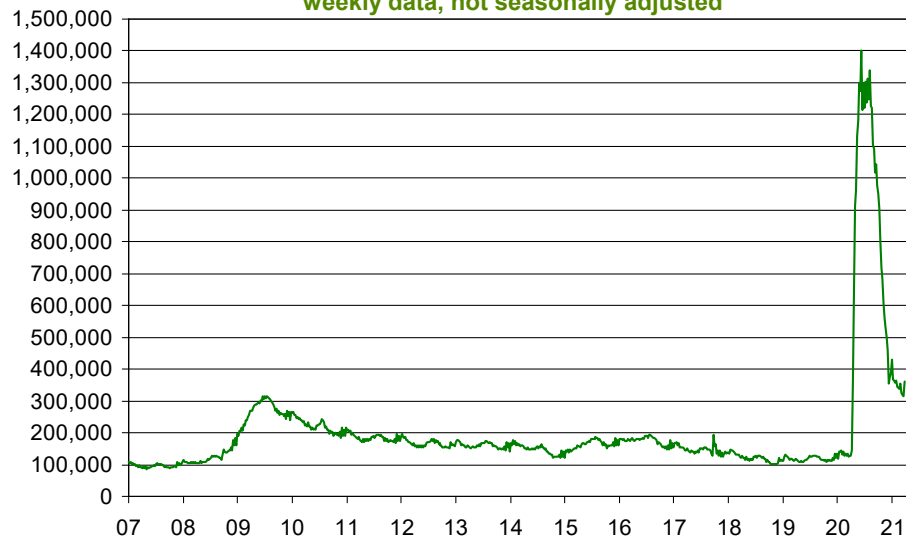

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



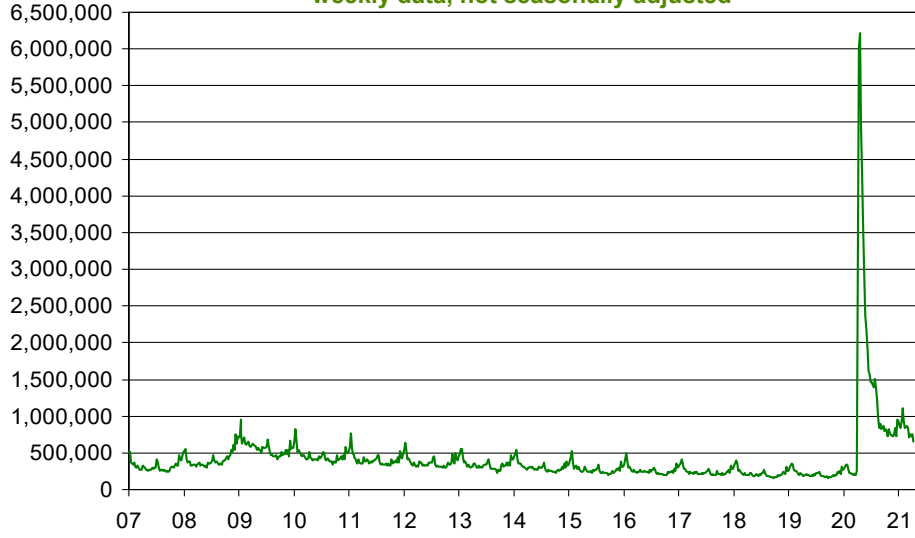

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



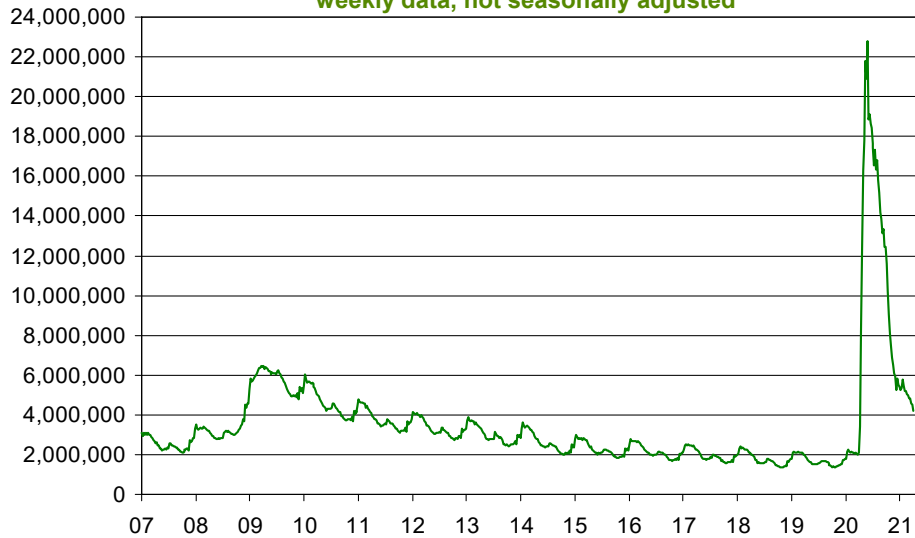
