Notes On Initial and Continuing Claims: Regions Footprint

Initial Claims:

During the week ending June 19, a total of 126,340 people within the Regions footprint applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits, down from 138,097 people in the week ending June 12;

Alabama, Indiana, and Texas saw increases in initial claims in the week ending June 19, with each of the remaining states seeing declines in initial claims;

Nationally, 359,130 people filed claims during the week ending June 26, down from 397,392 in the week ending June 19.

Continuing Claims:

As of the week ending June 12, a total of 1,007,709 people within the Regions footprint were receiving regular Unemployment Insurance benefits, up from 1,038,386 in the week ending June 5;

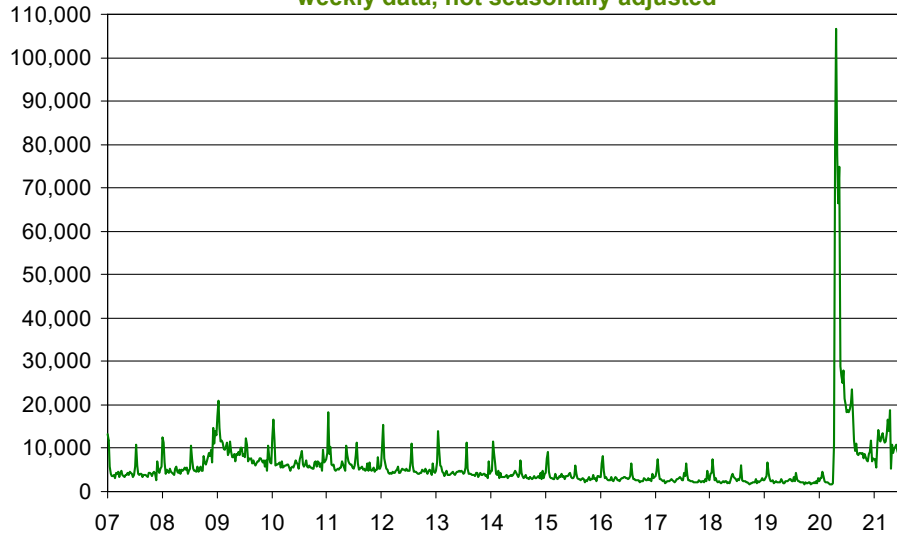
Arkansas, Georgia, Kentucky, and saw increases in continuing claims in the week ending June 12;

It should be noted that declines in continuing claims can reflect either people having exhausted their regular state-level benefits or having returned to work;

More than 2.662 million people across the Regions footprint are drawing Unemployment Insurance benefits through the various pandemic relief programs; these numbers are not included in the regular claims data cited above.

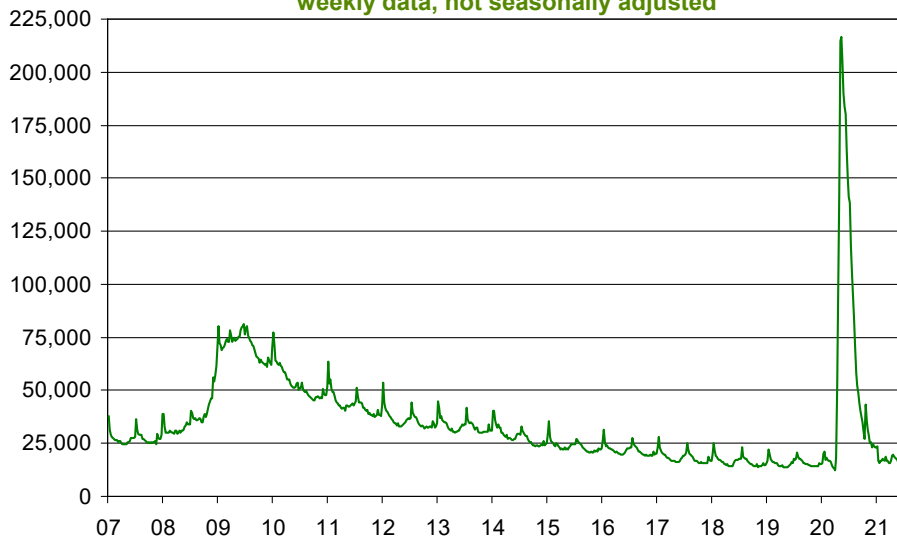

Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Alabama weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



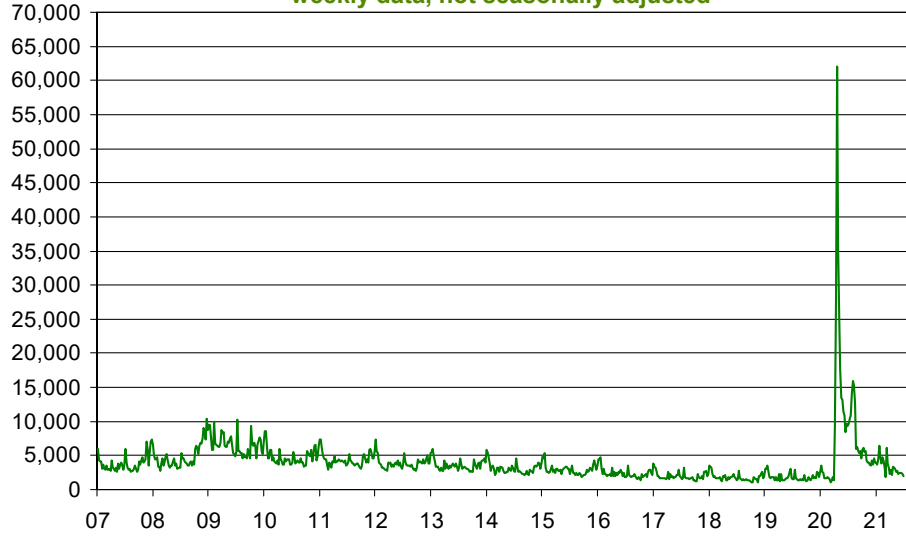

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



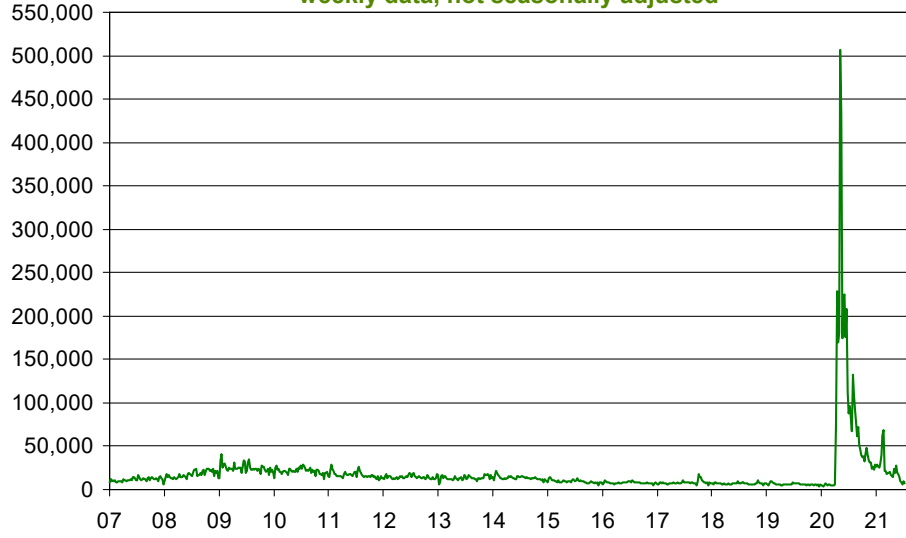

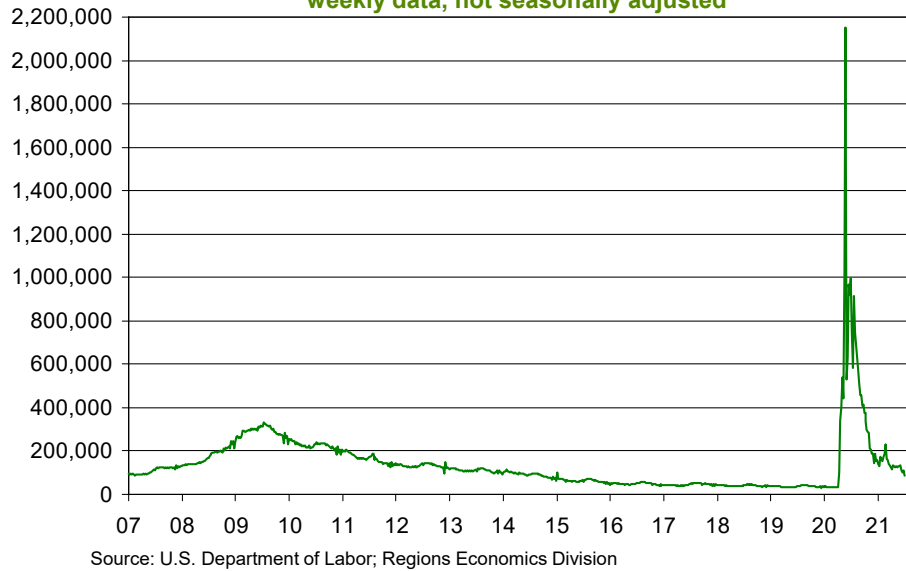


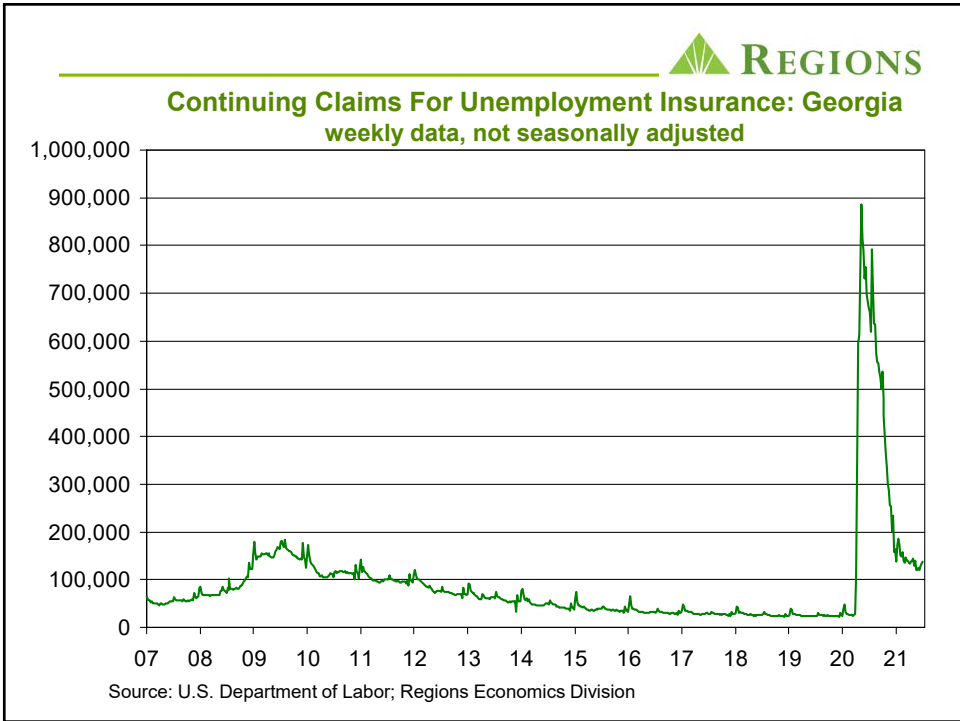

weekly data, not seasonally adjusted

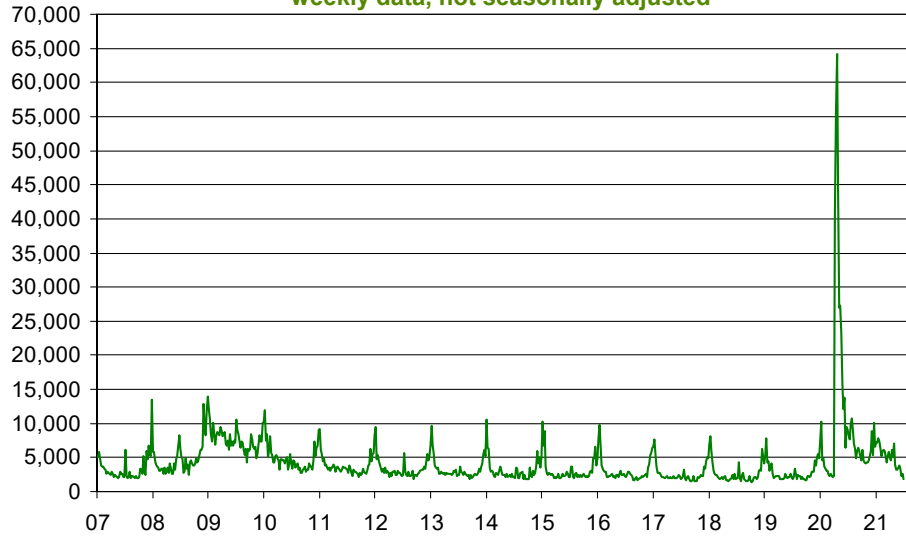


Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Florida
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



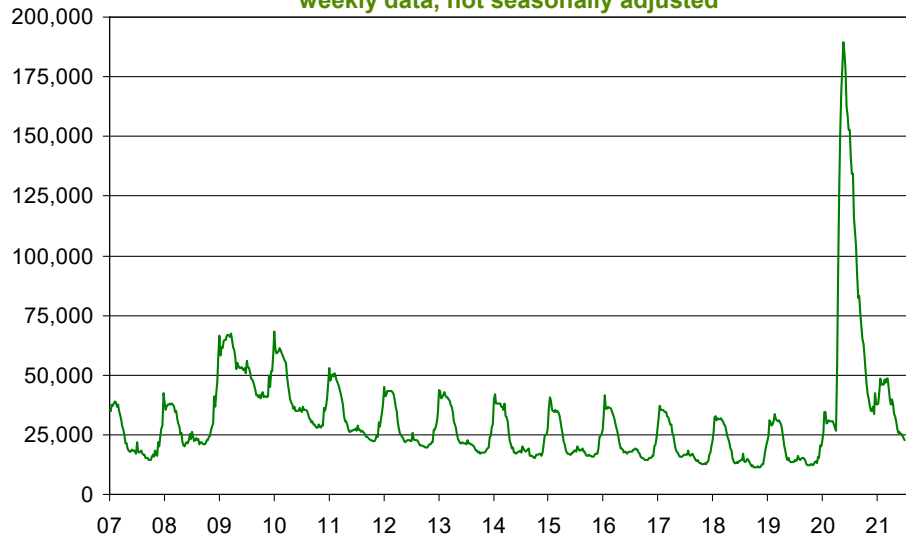


Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Iowa
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



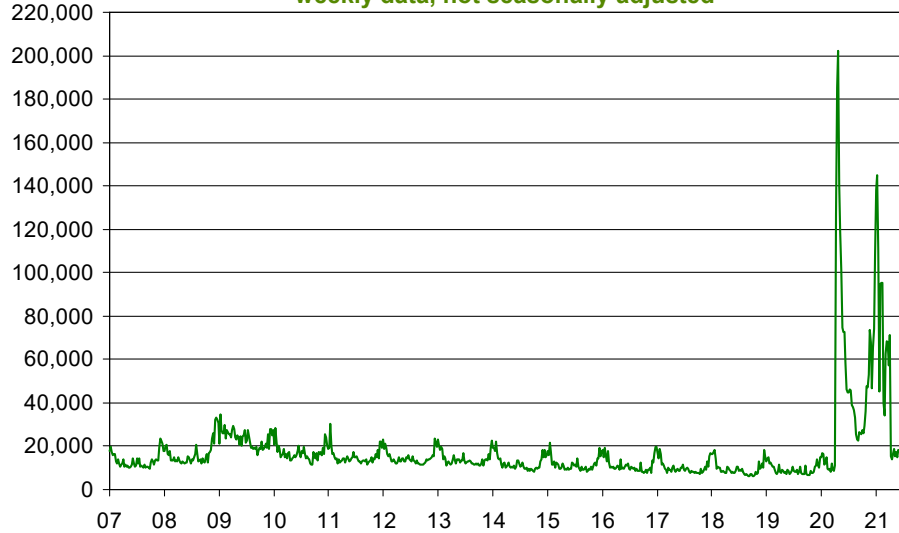

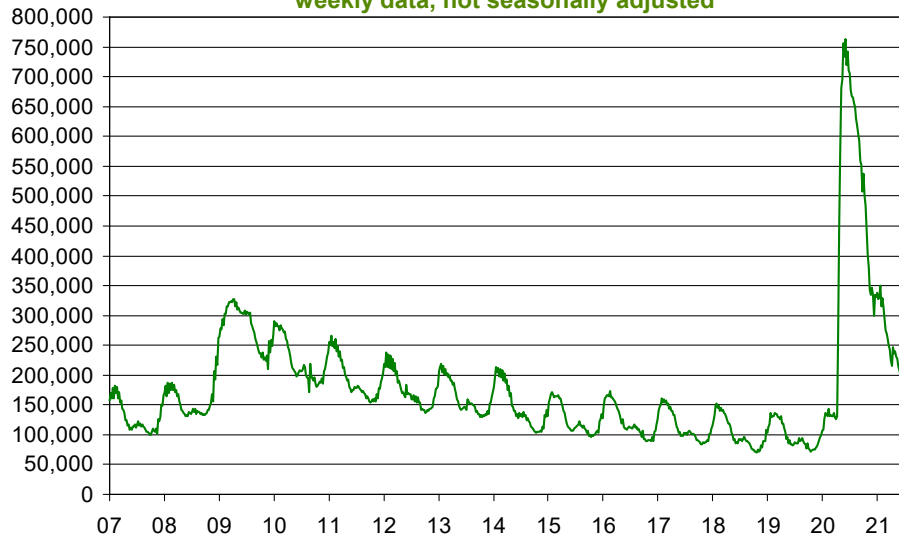

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



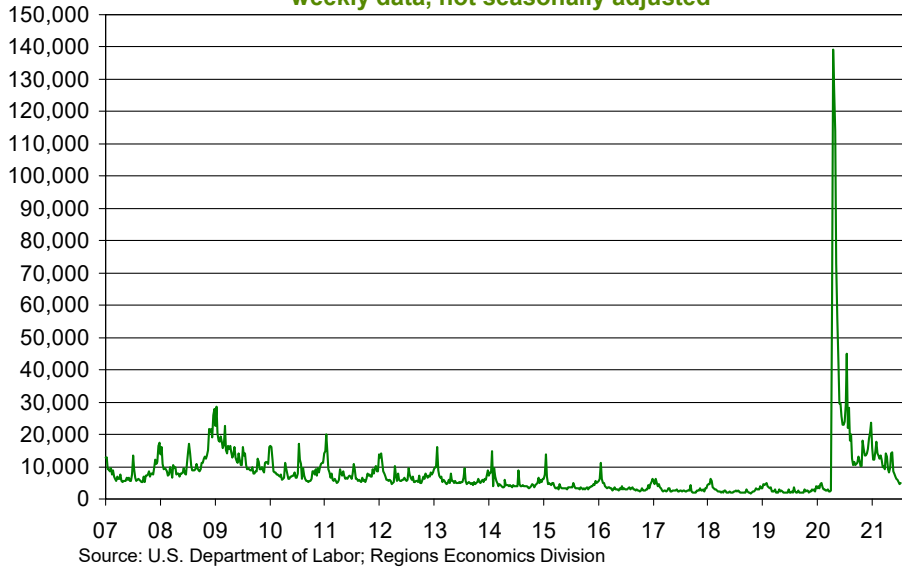

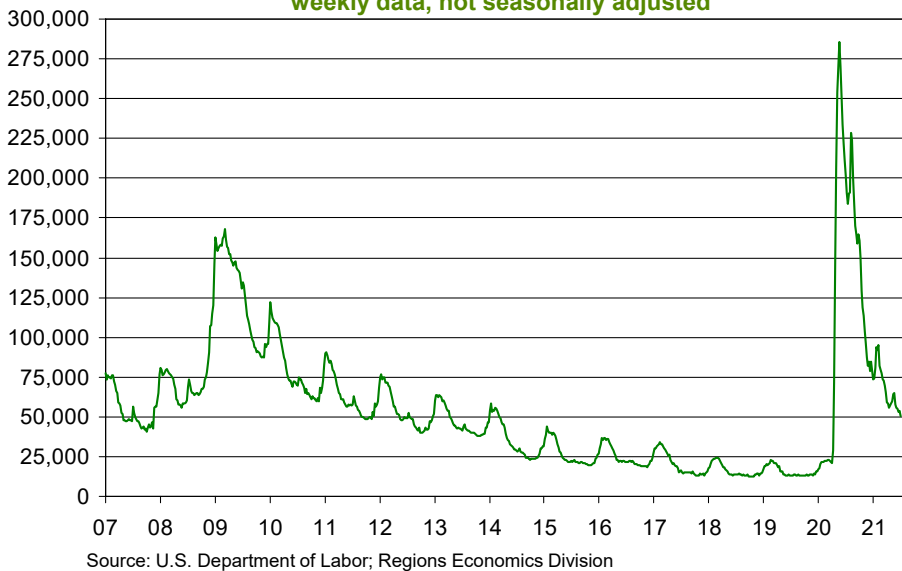

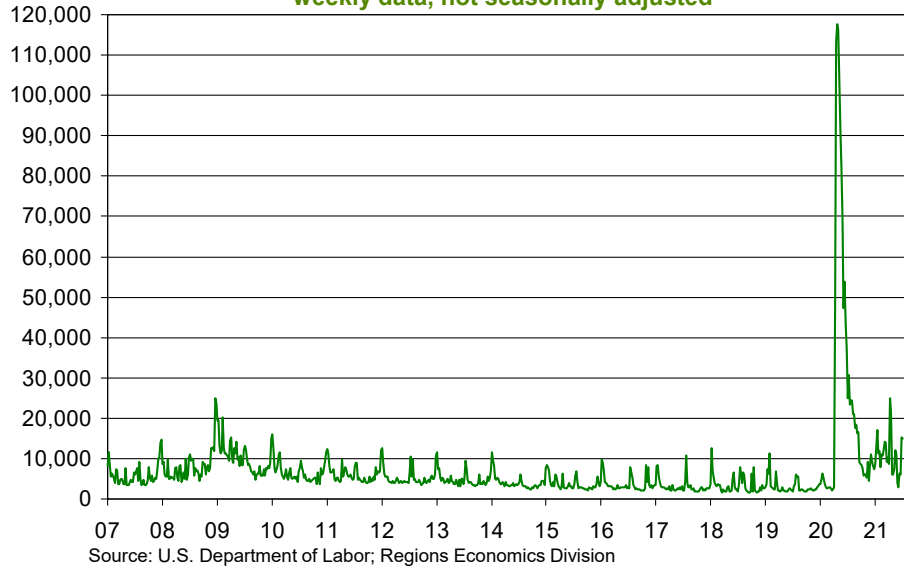
Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Indiana
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



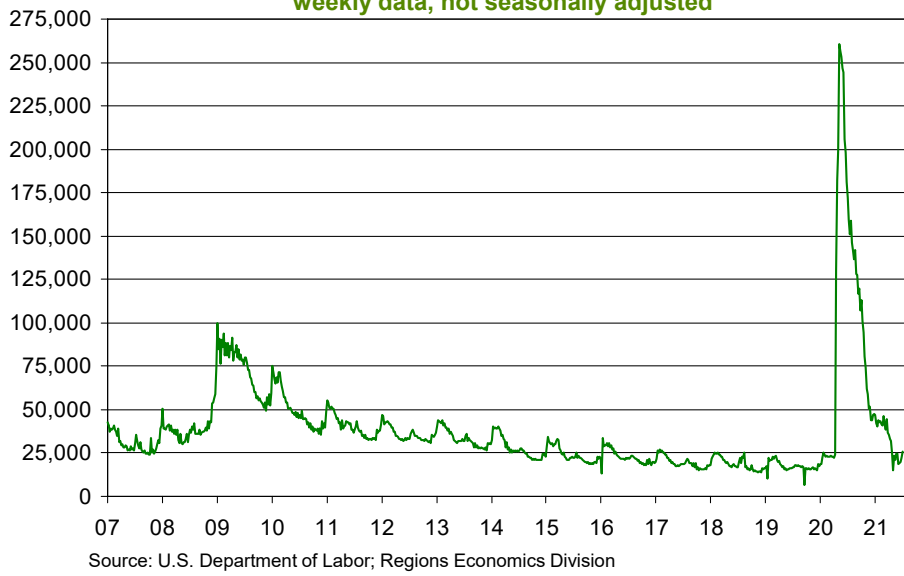
Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Indiana

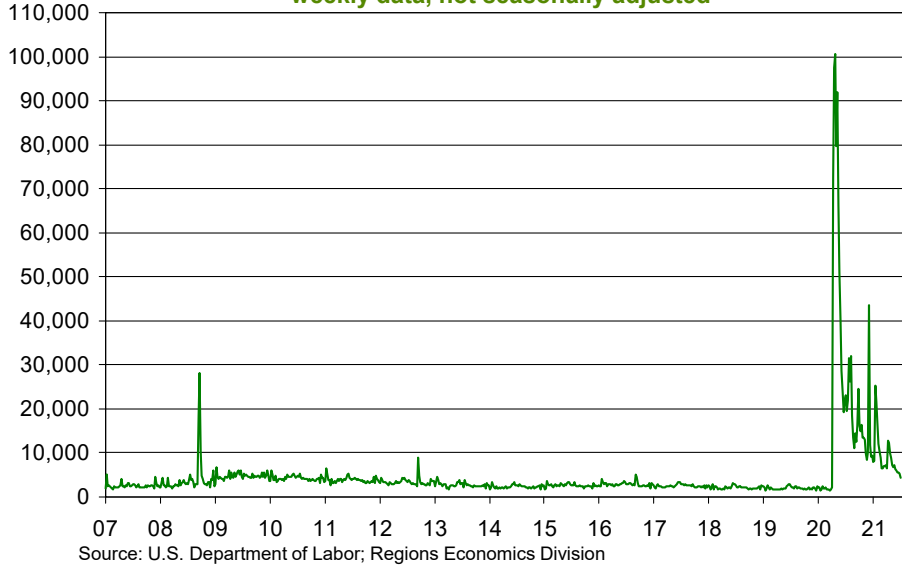
Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Kentucky
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



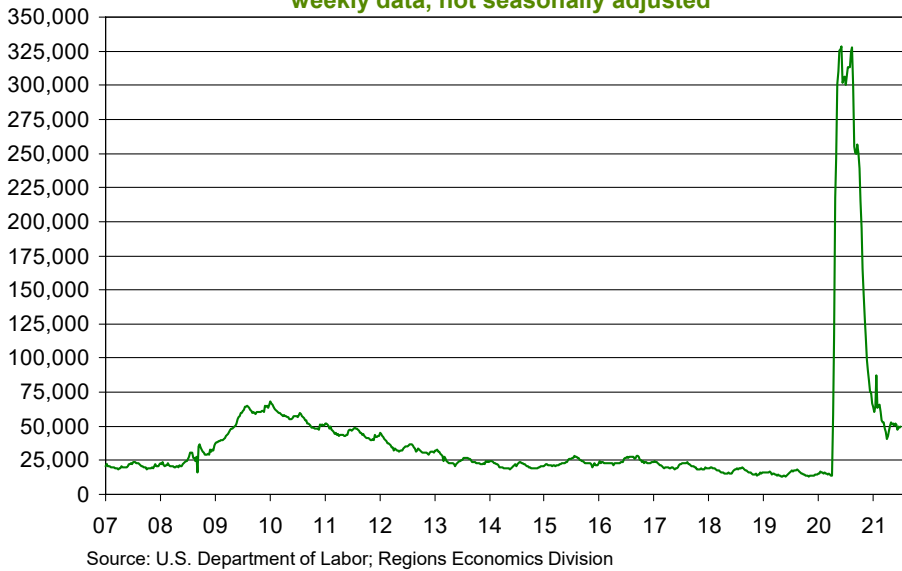

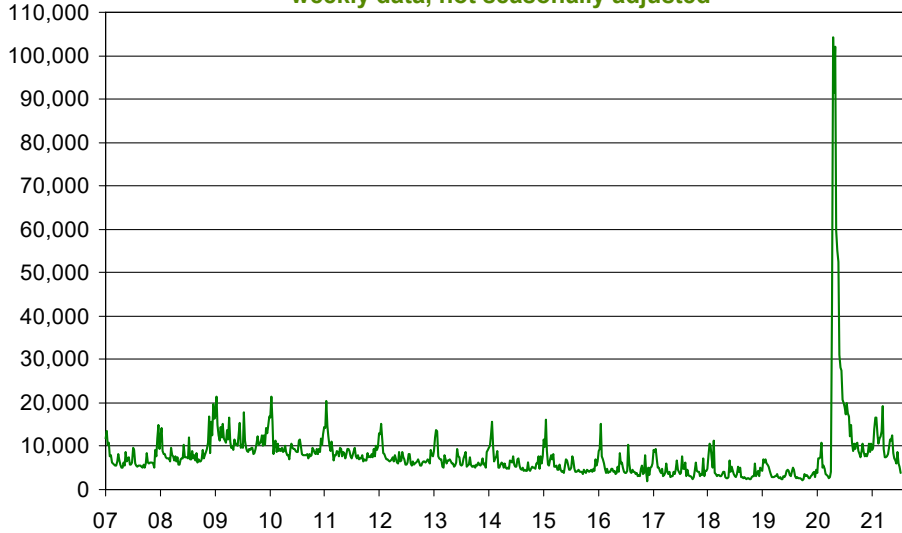
Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Louisiana

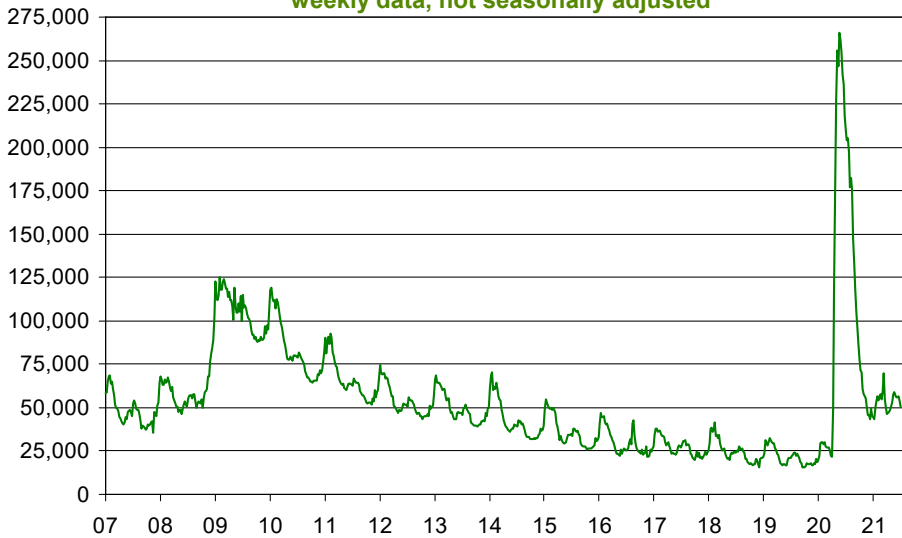


Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Missouri
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted

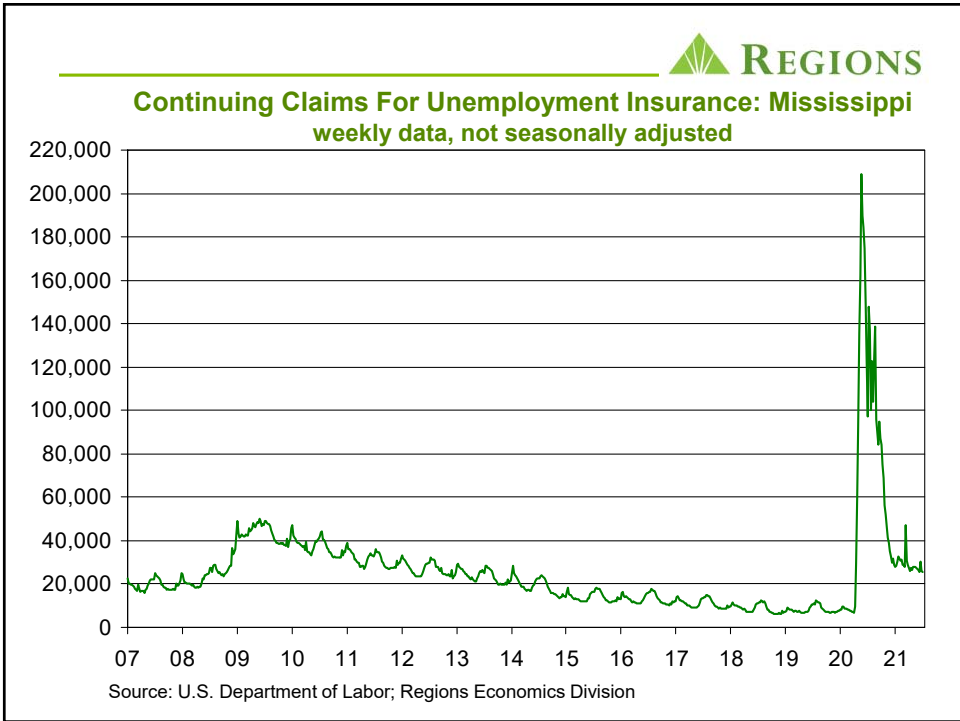
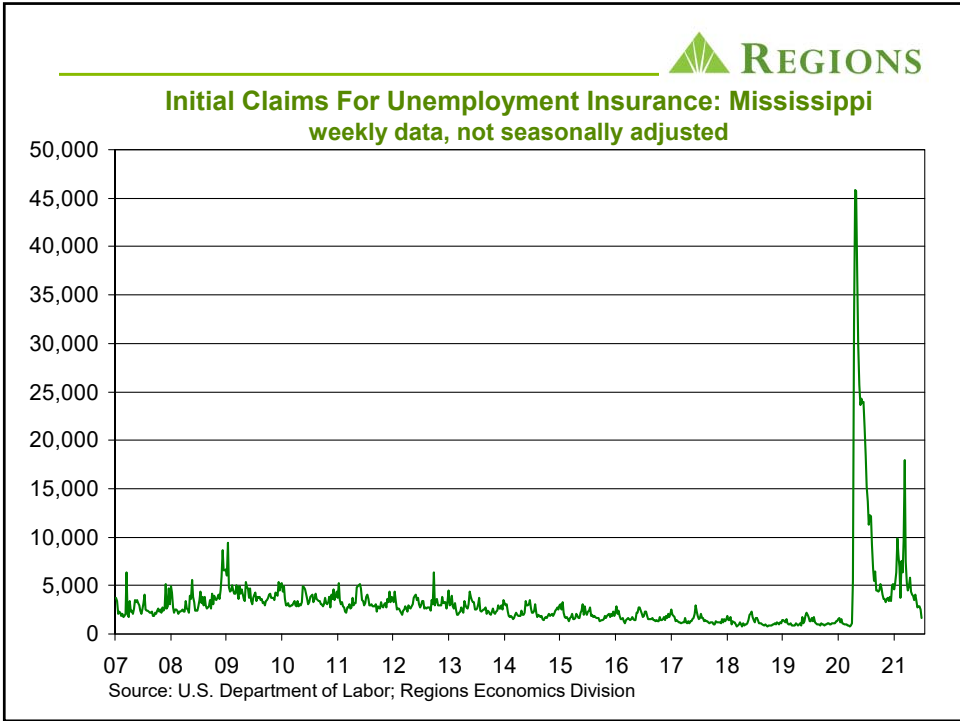

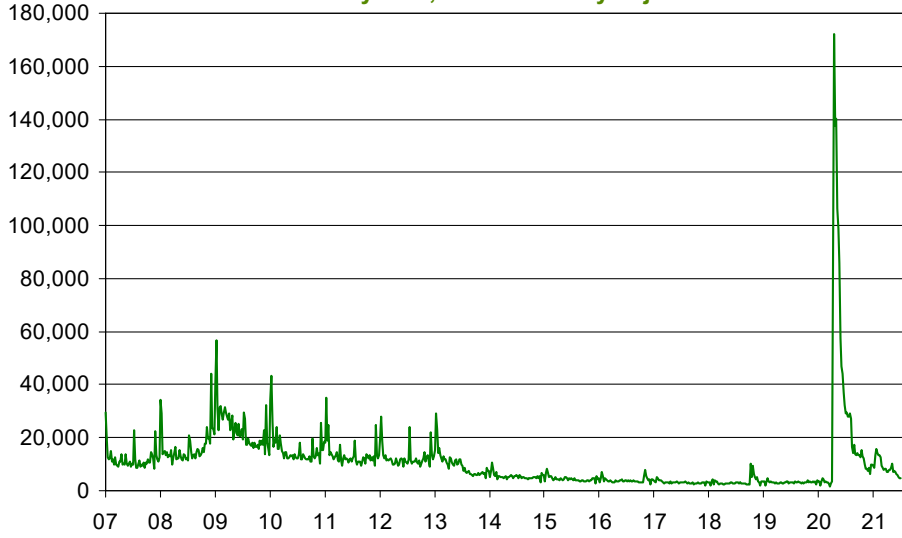
Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Missouri

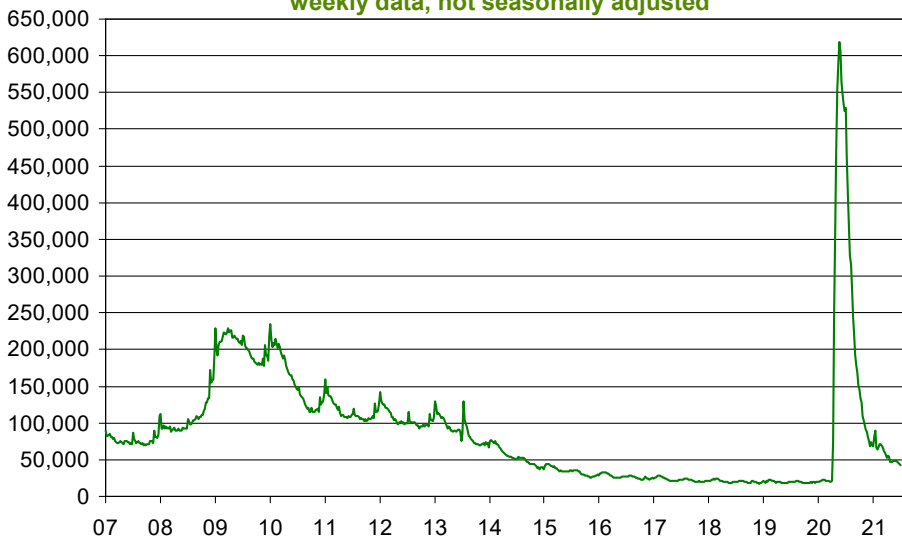


Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: North Carolina
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



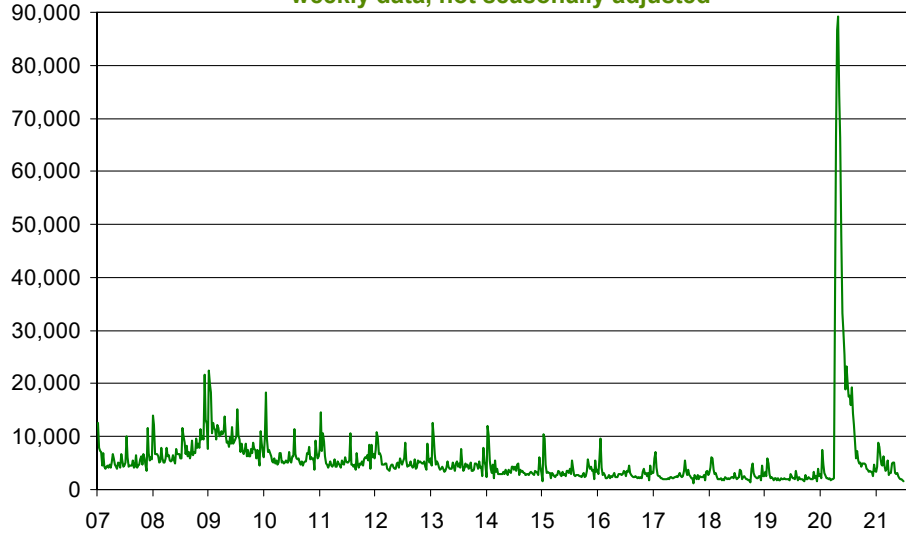

weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



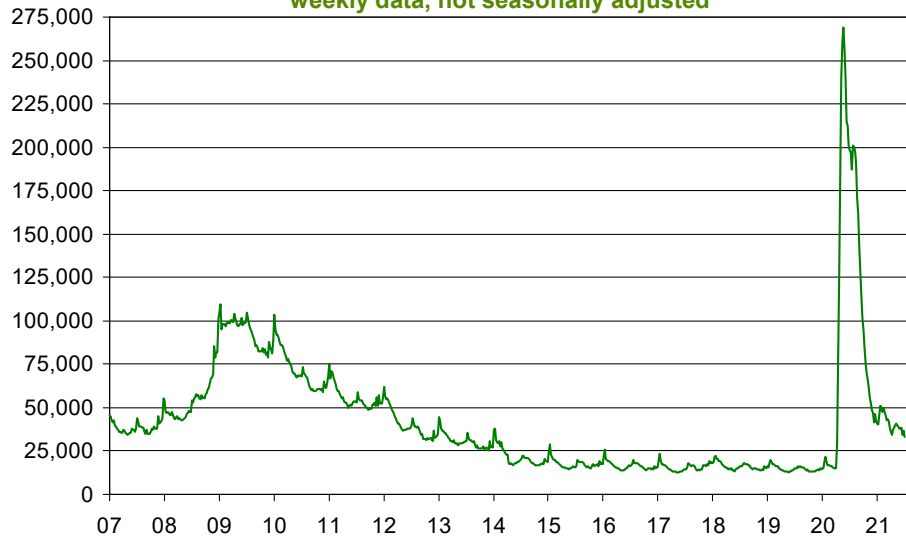

weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



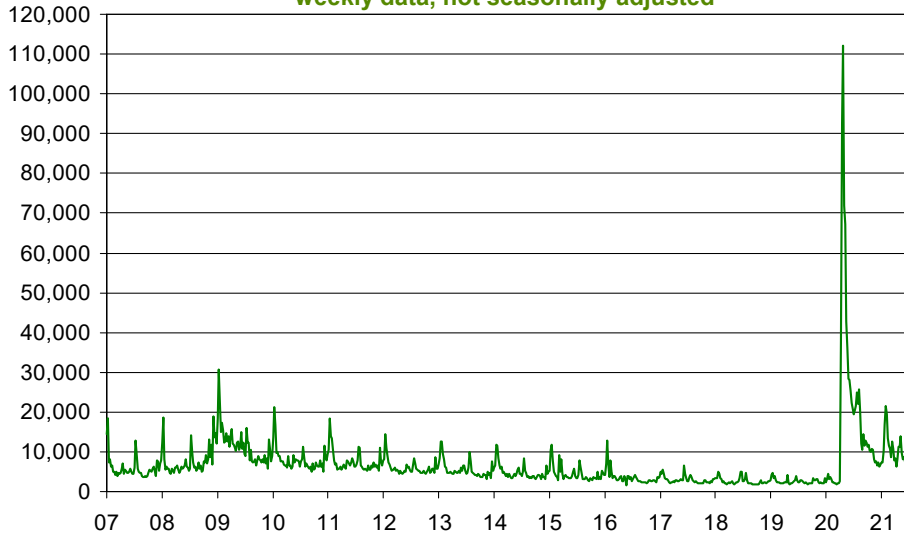

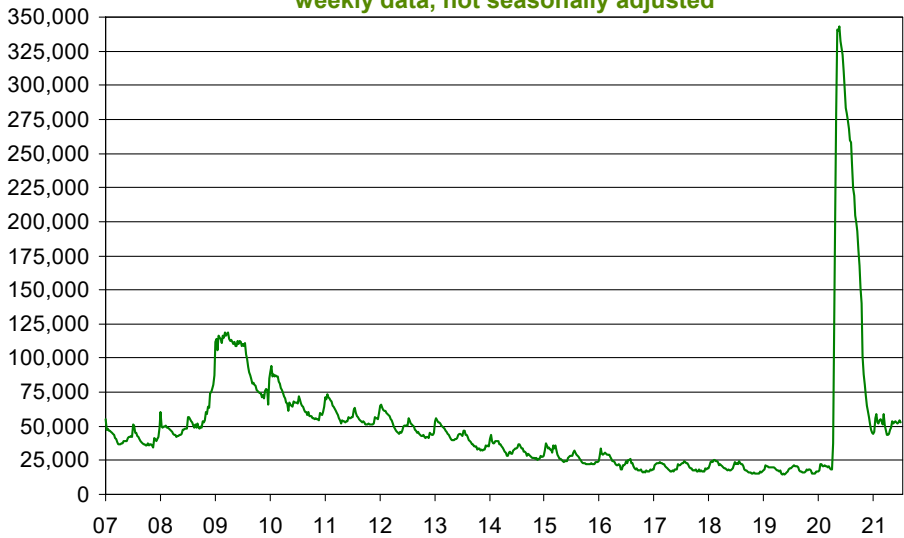

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



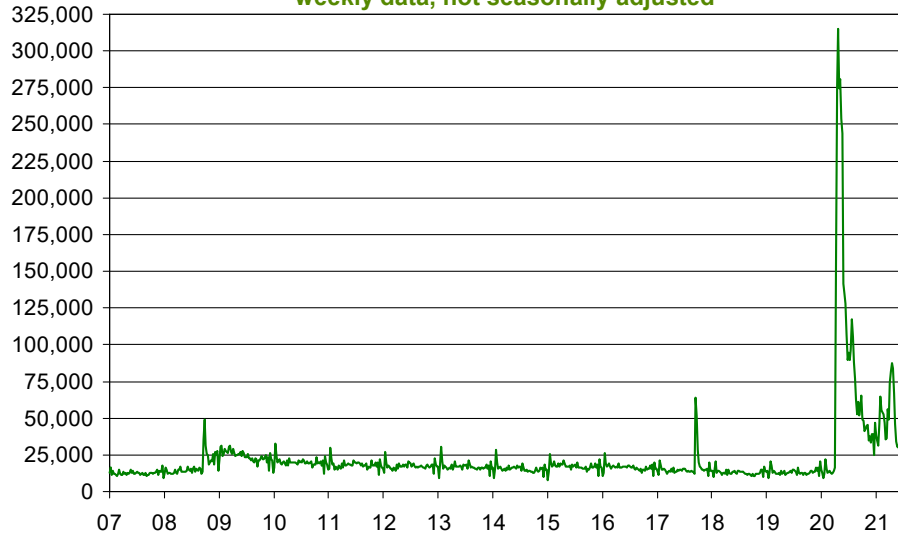

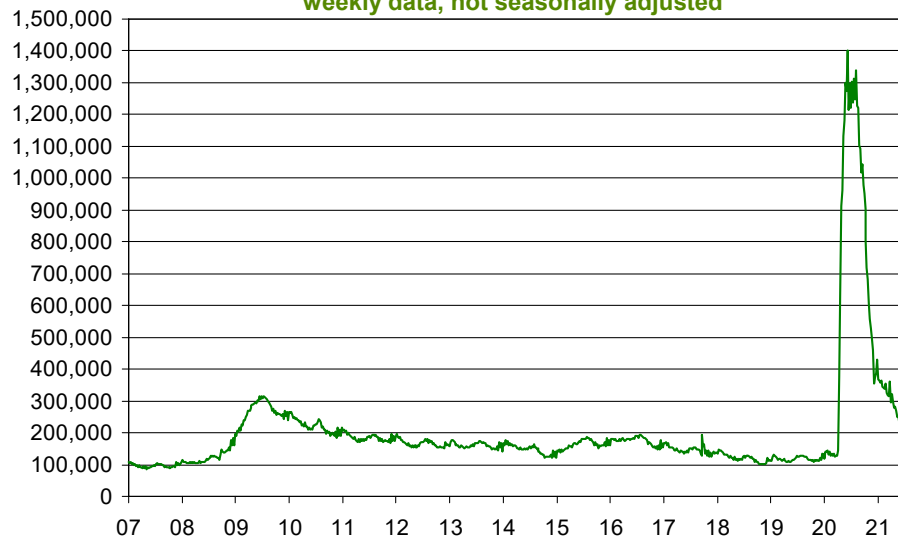

 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted



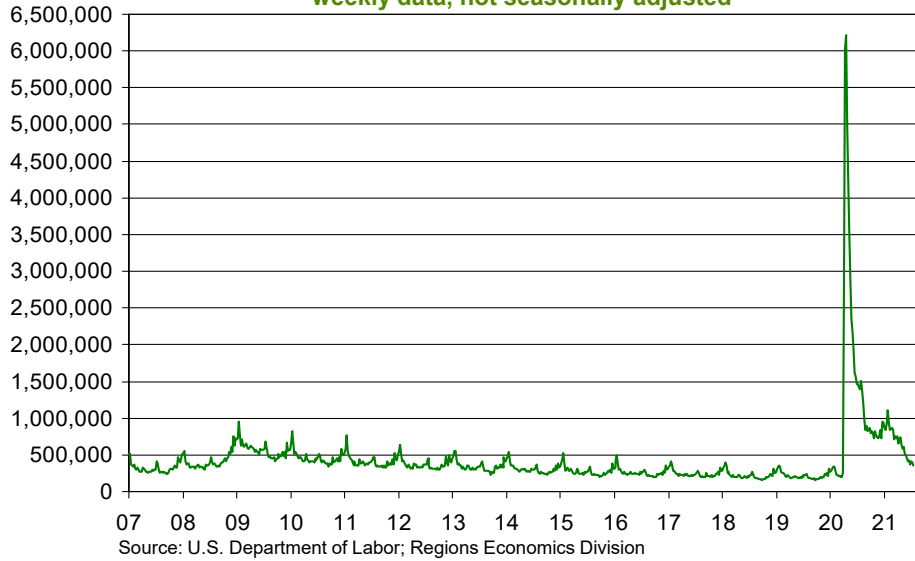
